Make a sheep mask

In today's video we learned that people are like sheep and Jesus is like a good shepherd who keeps us safe. Here's a mask you can make to remember you are like a sheep!

You will need:

- A paper plate or some white card
- If you're using card, a plate to draw around and a pencil/pen
- Scissors
- A stapler
- Elastic or string
- Cotton wool
- Glue

What to do:

To start you'll need a ring of card that fits around your face, so either:

Carefully cut the middle out of a paper plate, leaving a ring and a circle; or

Draw a big circle on card (you can use a plate to draw around) and then carefully cut out a smaller circle from inside.

Next, use the leftover card to cut out two sheep ear shapes. Staple these to the back of the ring to look like ears.

Now staple some elastic or string across the back of the ring to hold the mask on – you'll need to measure it to your head to make sure it fits.

Finally, turn over to make the front of your sheep mask. Put glue all over the ring of card and stick on plenty of cotton wool until it looks woolly!

Your sheep mask is ready to wear. You could write something on the back such as "Jesus is my shepherd."
